



JUNIOR MOTOCROSS TEAM MANAGER – Expression of Interest

Motorcycling NT, the governing body for motorcycle sport in the Northern Territory, is excited to announce a new opportunity for a motivated and experienced individual to join the team as the Team Manager of the NT Junior Motocross State Team. This is a key leadership role that will cover the 2024 KTM Australian Junior Motocross Championships, which will take place in Bunbury, Western Australia from the 24th to the 28th of September 2024. The successful candidate will lead the NT Junior Motocross Team and be responsible for managing the team in accordance with Motorcycling NT's high standards.

The ideal candidate should have an in-depth understanding of the standards and behaviors expected of an MNT Official and/or Representative Rider and should be willing to comply with these standards. They should possess the capacity to manage, organise, direct, and control the riders, gear, and other aspects of the team as appropriate. The candidate should have a high degree of initiative and organisational ability, mature judgment, and should be able to accept responsibility. Good interpersonal skills are essential, as is the ability to communicate effectively in oral and written forms. The candidate should demonstrate the ability to work well under pressure while achieving objectives and must provide a written plan or outline of team objectives and how they will be achieved. Finally, the candidate must possess a current Working With Children Check.

Responsibilities of the Team Manager include selecting eight NT team riders from a minimum of four classes to compete in the Interstate Cup Challenge as per section 8.21.4 in the 2024 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS). The candidate will become conversant with the General Competition Rules (GCRs), Final Instructions, and any other requirements for the event. They will be expected to organise a Team NT track walk, as well as a Team NT photograph, ensuring that all riders and support personnel are in the correct uniform. The successful candidate will be responsible for ensuring that the conduct of the team is beyond reproach, and they must submit a written report to MNT following the event.

This is a volunteer position, and as such, the successful candidate will be partially compensated for their time spent attending the KTM Australian Junior Motocross Championship.
