Database update

Major concerns raised at last meeting 3 items still outstanding, 1 of these is an issue with NAB. Voucher acceptance is in UAT. The event payment report is in place but needs to be improved. 55 updates have been completed since last meeting.

The agreement to test every item by the Ridernet committee has not gone as well as expected, so some testing is behind.

In January RNC agreed for all the bugs and current issues to be resolved before any further builds are to be started within RN2.

Members and Officials imports are still in progress. Selection of riding numbers have been disabled by all states until the system is working correctly as duplicate riding numbers have been acquired.

Medical Standards

Approved by MA and AMT – implemented for 2023

One day memberships are an issue in regard to permits, a club day and a state event are essentially the same in some cases. SCB's need to be careful that having what in reality is an open event running with club level medical may create problems.

National Calendar

National calendar has been delivered and a meeting held with SCB representatives, MP thanked MANT for input into the calendar. Updated calendar has been sent out. Technical compliance at state level road events has been raised. No update on WJMX qualifying from the working group.
